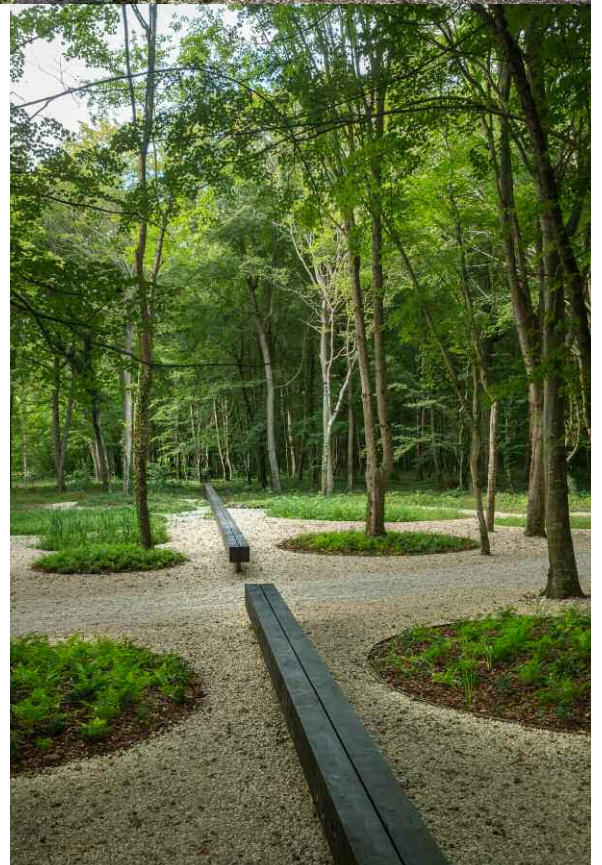

The Gardens of Peace Hauts-de-France - Grand Est - Belgium

A landscaped tour of the memorial sites of the Great War

A unique landscape project on the emblematic sites of remembrance of the First World War, the Art & Jardins association | Hauts-de-France, the Mission of the Centenary of the First World War and the Ministry of the Armed Forces have developed a creative and innovative journey in the colours of the nations that were at war and who now embrace the cause of peace in the contemporary world. It is an invitation to landscape architects and architects from the warring countries, to trace avenues of reflection on a world that is marked by economic, political and ecological upheavals.

Since 2018, the centenary year marking the end of the First World War, 20 Gardens of Peace have been created in Hauts-de-France, Belgium and now in the Grand Est. They offer a different, sensitive and complementary approach to places of memory: from the moat of the Château in Péronne to those of the Vauban fortifications in Le Quesnoy, from the Glade of the armistice in the forest of Compiègne to the village of Vieux-Craonne on the Chemin des Dames, via the Targette in Neuville-Saint-Vaast, Arras, Thiepval, Vimy, Notre-Dame-de-Lorette, Richebourg, Noyelles-sur-Mer, Braine, Vouziers and also to Passchendaele in Belgium. Created with the support of local authorities, these Gardens of Peace create spaces for rest and reflection, offering an alternative perspective on our future and on peace which is always in question.

Art & Jardins | Hauts-de-France sought to extend its Gardens of Peace project beyond the Hauts-de-France region. A three-year agreement was signed with the Ministry of the Armed Forces at the end of 2020 to extend its deployment to the region of the Grand Est; initial contacts have been made with various agencies and the different communities. In 2022-2023, 13 Gardens of Peace will be created near or within national necropolises, on sites identified in consultation with the Department of Heritage, Memory and the Ministerial archives.

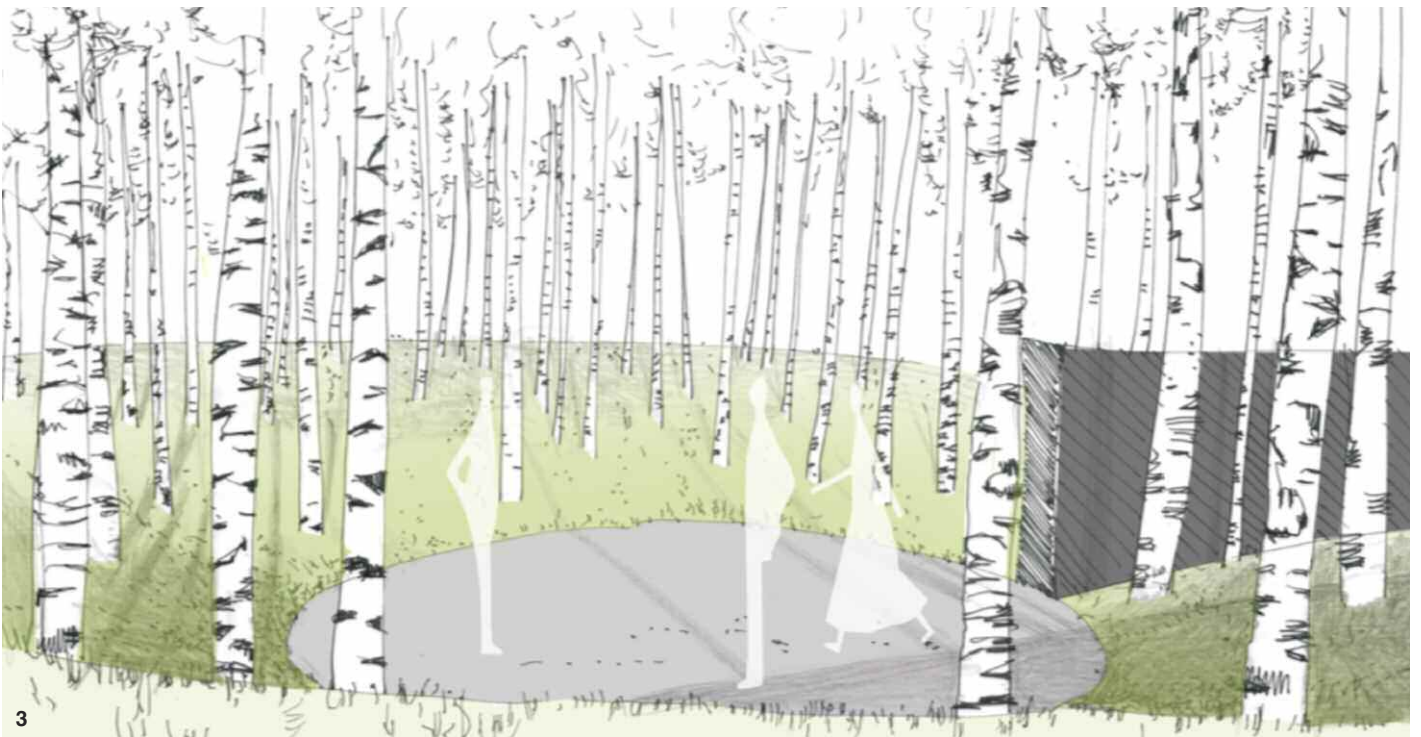
By 2024, a Path of Peace - made up of nearly 40 gardens dedicated to the First World War and situated along the front line - will emerge from the borders of Belgium to Alsace via the departments of the Nord, Pas-de-Calais, Somme, Aisne, Oise, Ardennes, Marne, Meuse, Moselle, Meurthe-et-Moselle, Vosges, Bas-Rhin and Haut-Rhin. In 2022, 10 new Gardens of Peace will be launched in the Grand Est and the Hauts-de-France regions.

This Path of Peace, which is unprecedented in France and in Europe, will form a complementary itinerary to the traditional circuit of Memory. It will be enhanced in 2024 by the publication of a new book presenting all the landscape works of the two regions which will retrace this formidable human adventure.

Process of creating a Garden of Peace

Having chosen the sites with the institutional partners, the association launches an international call for projects for each garden, which is open to landscapers and architects from the nations concerned by the places of memory. Then a jury of international landscape and architectural experts, institutional partners, sponsors and members of the association - select the winners. The association then consults with the landscapers who are paid fees for the design and construction. It also mobilises local service providers for the realisation of the garden and supervises the conception of the project with the landscapers. Finally, for the association, the question of maintenance is an essential condition for the sustainability of the gardens. Once the work has been completed, the Garden of Peace is inaugurated in the presence of the sponsors and the partners.

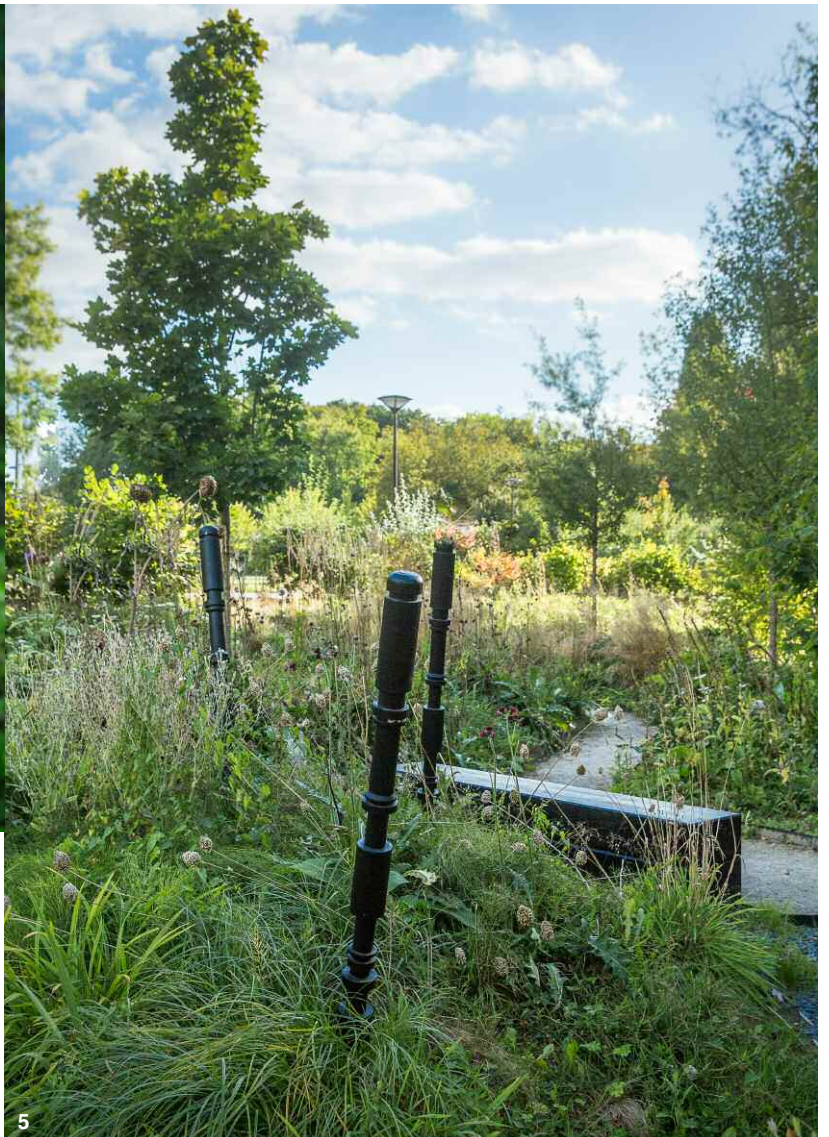

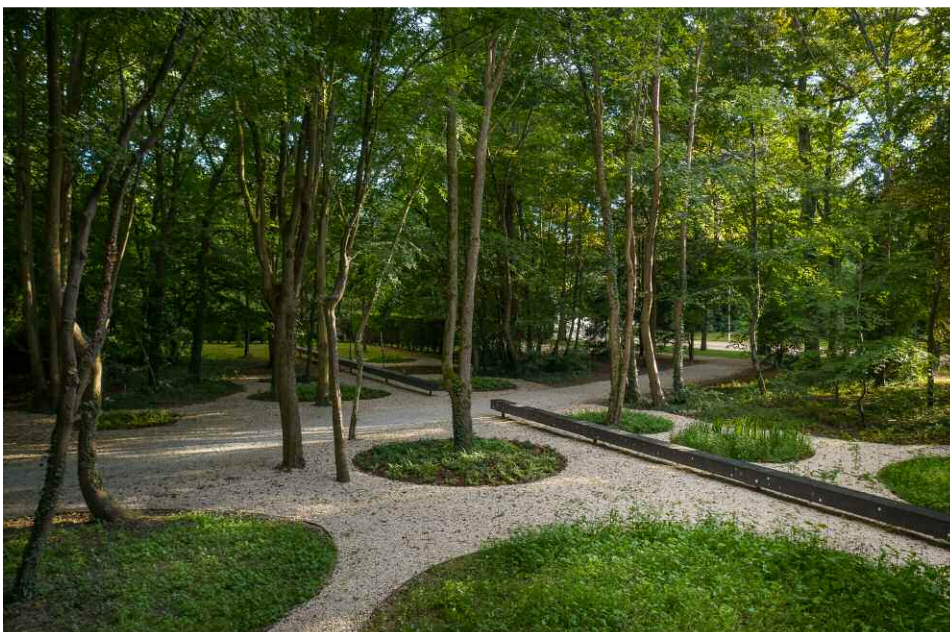

The Art & Jardins association | Hauts-de-France



Since 2017 on the initiative of the Hauts-de-France Region, Art & Jardins | Hauts-de-France a unique project has been deployed around the theme of the garden. After taking over the organisation of the *International Garden Festival / Hortillonnages Amiens*, a project was initiated by creating *Gardens of Peace* on the whole of the Hauts-de-France territory with the support of the Mission of the Centenary of the First World War.

A true catalyst of emotions and developer of talents, the association Art & Jardins | Hauts-de-France has several objectives:

- **To assert itself as a production structure** and to support landscape, architectural and plastic creation, with a particular focus on young designers
- **To question natural and heritage sites** to enhance and preserve the patrimonial and cultural heritage while developing the attractiveness of the territory, and stimulating economic development
- **To encourage reflections about Peace**, its memory, its preservation at a time when Europe is looking inwardly and when it is essential to remember that European construction was built on peace and that peace is the future of our planet
- **To encourage professional integration** with an insertion workshop and an accreditation for volunteering in civic service as well as a partnership with the prison administration
- **To re-examine the nutritional capabilities** of certain sites, and more broadly to integrate the societal and environmental issues - particularly those of water, food and climate change
- **To participate in the social and solidarity economy** by distributing the food that is produced.
- **To encounter new audiences**, especially the younger generations with little or no access to culture, to raise their awareness of creation, landscape, food production, short supply chains, eating well, the issues of climate change, and to be involved in group and civic actions
- **To build international partnerships** around our artistic, ecological, social and societal approach and preoccupations.

A label of artistic & landscaped creation in the service of a territory

In order to meet these objectives Art & Jardins I Hauts-de-France is deploying several structuring projects:

- The creation of *Gardens of Peace* in the Hauts-de-France, the Grand Est and in Belgium.
- The establishment of strong local partnerships with the Mining Basin: five *participatory citizen's gardens* were created in 2019-2020 in Lens, Calonne-Ricouart and Grenay by mobilising our teams.
- The production and organisation of the International *Garden Festival | Hortillonnages Amiens* (created in 2010 by the Maison de la Culture d'Amiens) which celebrated its 12th edition in 2021. True artistic originality, this event has welcomed 450,000 visitors to date and enabled the creation of 170 works by 245 visual artists, landscapers and architects.
- The enhancement of the Somme Valley with the design of landscaped gardens from Saint-Quentin to the Bay of the Somme, thus participating in departmental itineraries along the river and becoming part of a major regional project. This project will be extended and developed within the framework of a partnership with the Departmental Council of the Somme.
- The development of cultural and artistic partnerships with *lille 3000* (participation in *Eldorado* in 2019 and *Utopia* in 2022).
- In partnership with the Rectorates of the Academies in Lille and Amiens, and in conjunction with the services of the Hauts-de-France Region, the association is also working on the creation of *vegetable and educational gardens in high schools* to raise awareness among young people of nourishment and healthy eating, short circuits and the societal challenges of tomorrow linked to climate change: Pasteur high school in Lille, Pierre de Coubertin high school in Calais, Delambre high school in Amiens, Cassini high school in Clermont de l'Oise, Chauny high schools.
- The exchange of expertise and experience internationally with Franco-Belgian and Franco-English cross-border projects, but also with Morocco. Cooperation agreements have in particular been concluded with the School of Architecture of Marrakech in Morocco and with the Memorial Museum Passchendaele 1917 for the creation of a *Belgian Garden of Peace* in France at Le Quesnoy and a *French Garden of Peace* in Passchendaele in Belgium (European project PLATO). From June to November 2021, an exhibition of photos of our achievements was displayed at the Schloss Dyck Foundation in the Rhineland.

The association in numbers (2021)

- More than 40 artists and landscapers under contract
- 50 regional service providers under contract
- More than 45 employees including an integration project of 17 agents
- 10 volunteers in civic service
- A regional collection of 86 contemporary landscape and plastic works
- A target of 110 contemporary, landscaped and architectural permanent exhibits by 2023 / An attendance of 1 million visitors and tourists per year to the sites

To carry out these missions, Art & Jardins I Hauts-de-France is supported by the Hauts-de-France Region, Europe, the French State (Ministry of the Armed Forces, DREETS), Amiens Métropole, the Departmental Council of Pas-de-Calais, the Departmental Council of Somme, the Community of Agglomeration of Lens-Liévin, the Community of Agglomeration of Cambrai, the Community of Agglomeration of Béthune-Bruay Artois Lys Romane, as well as many sponsors, the French Institute and foreign embassies.

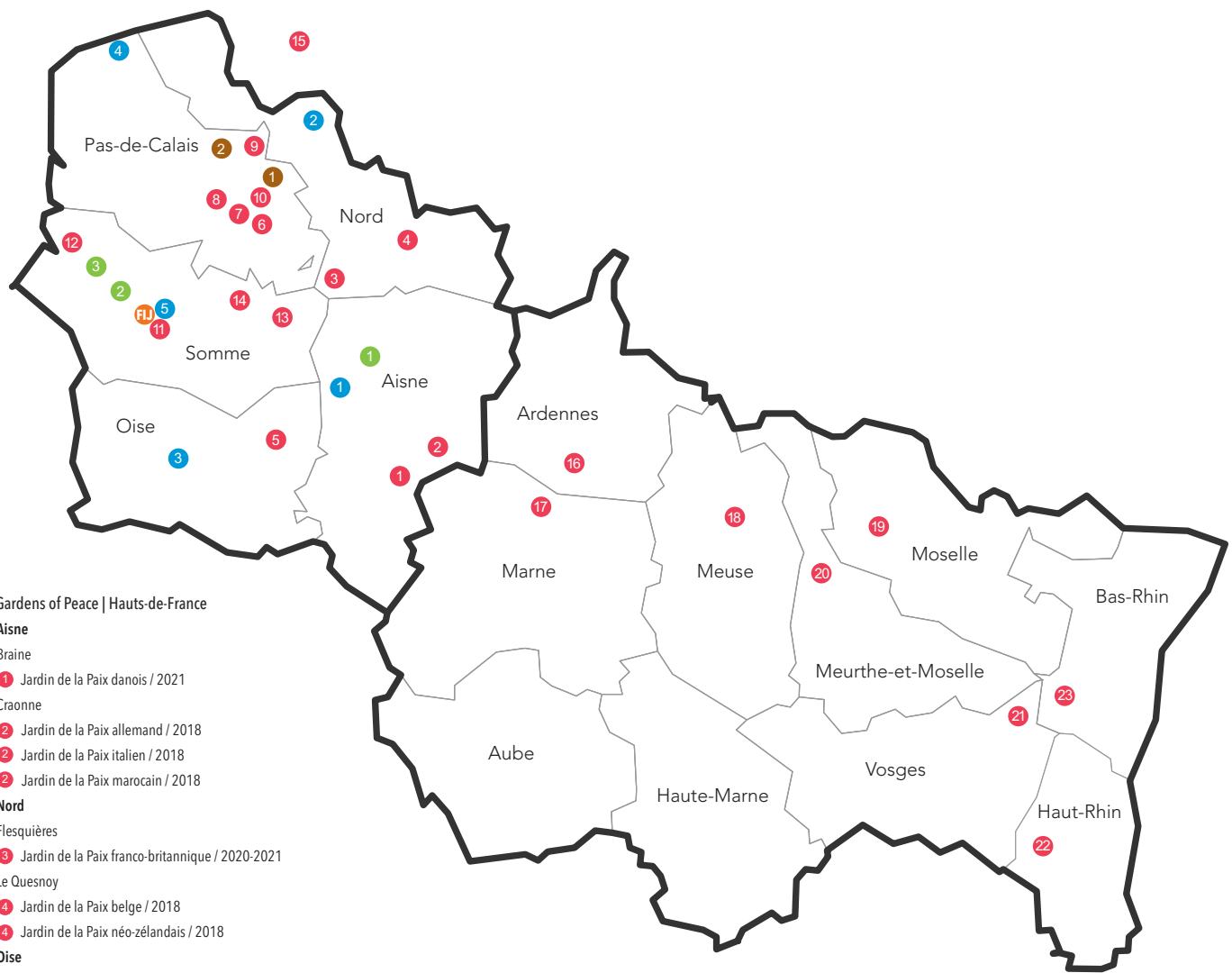
